- O Distilled water

- Painkillers
- Rolled crepe bandages

- O Skin rash cream (such as hydrocortisone or calendula)
- Sterile eye patches (for adults and kids)
- O Sterile gauze pads (small, medium, and large)

- Triangular bandages
