WOOD

- Hefty weight
- Stable, tight joints
- Smooth, even finish
- No significant scratches, dents, or scuff marks



STONE OR METAL

- Cold to the touch
- Stable, uniform joints, especially where bonded with other materials
- No cracks, rust, or stains



UPHOLSTERY

- Smooth, consistent seams
- Aligned patterns between fabric panels
- Double-rub count between 12,000 and 20,000
(check the fabric's tag or ask a representative)
- Comfortable to relax on
