 <b>Beans</b>	Broccoli, carrots, corn, cucumbers, peas, strawberries, chard, eggplant	Onions, garlic
 <b>Carrots</b>	Peas, lettuce, onions, sage, tomatoes, radishes, beans, chives, peppers, rosemary	Dill
 <b>Cucumbers</b>	Beans, peas, radishes, corn, dill, lettuce, tomatoes	Sage
 <b>Lettuce</b>	Carrots, radishes, strawberries, onions, cucumbers, beans, garlic, tomatoes	Parsley
 <b>Onions</b>	Beets, carrots, lettuce, strawberries, chard, tomatoes	Asparagus, beans, peas
 <b>Peppers</b>	Basil, carrots, onions, tomatoes, spinach, cilantro	Beans, fennel, broccoli
 <b>Potatoes</b>	Beans, horseradish, corn, peas, celery, radishes, garlic	Tomatoes
