AFRICAN VIOLET

- Known for: Small, bright flowers (usually purple) and fuzzy green leaves
- Great for: Drawing attention toward smaller spaces, such as side tables, countertops, and bookshelves
- Care for: Set it in a self-watering planter in indirect light, and change the water weekly. Fertilize it with highphosphorous feed every two weeks in spring and summer.

ANTHURIUM

- Known for: Broad, colorful flowers with a tall center and waxy leaves
- Great for: Creating an eye-catching centerpiece on your countertops or coffee table
- Care for: Place it in organic soil and in bright, indirect sun.
 Mist it with water often, keep the soil moist, and feed it high-phosphorous fertilizer biweekly in warmer months.

OLIVE TREE

- Known for: Long, deep-green leaves and a dense canopy atop a thin stem
- Great for: Drawing the eye upward in a large room with low, bulky furniture and adding a distinctly Mediterranean vibe to its surroundings
- Care for: Plant it in loam-based, peat-free compost in a well-draining pot. Water it occasionally, and add liquidbased feed every two weeks in warm months.

SNAKE PLANT

- Known for: Tall, green, and sharp leaves that grow vertically
- Great for: Filling an empty corner or creating visual contrast beside a wide object like a sofa or sideboard
- Care for: Place it in well-draining cactus soil in plentiful indirect light. Water it only occasionally, when the soil is dry (about every two to three weeks).

VASE OF ROSES

- Known for: Vibrant blooms in a variety of different colors
- Great for: Adding instant elegance to any room
- Care for: Add in lukewarm water with flower food to a vase. Trim the flower stems at a 45-degree angle, place them in the vase, and set it near indirect light. Change the water and feed it every few days.
